## Preventing fires

### Smoking ban

- There is absolute smoking ban in the entire building
- Also affects e-cigarettes and any type of open light (candles, incense sticks etc.)  
Smoking electrical appliances are prohibited
- such as kettle, coffee machine, microwave etc.

### Smoke detector

- In the rooms there are smoke detectors with numbers on the ceiling to be able to trace where the alarm comes from
- The smoke detectors directly alarm the fire brigade
- Deployment of police, ambulance, fire brigade are automatically informed
- If the alarm is triggered by your own fault, you are liable for the costs of the operation

## What to do in an emergency

### Alarm sounds

- Stay calm
- all locked doors (locking system) unlock automatically
- Make sure that everyone in the room is outside

- If possible, close doors and windows
- Emergency lighting is in the corridors
- Follow the marked green escape route signs
- An escape and rescue plan is in each room
- Every door / window can and may be opened in case of fire or other emergencies
- Emergency button for opening is next to the doors
- Yellow smoke protection doors close automatically, but can be opened at any time via the door handle
- Set for the meeting point = schoolyard

### Report a fire

- If a student detects a fire, report it immediately
- Either via the emergency number: 112 or
- Activating the manual fire detector
- Make attempts to extinguish fires, use fire extinguishers, if possible several at the same time
- They hang in the corridors
- **Important: Rescuing people takes precedence over firefighting!**

### Make an emergency call

- Where is the fire? (Place, street, house number, building -> e.g. Bad Wörishofen dormitory, Oststraße 38,...)
- What is on fire?
- How much is burning? (e.g. small fire or complete building)
- What are the dangers? (are people at risk, dangerous substances,...?)
- Wait for questions!

Keep calm

Report the fire



Actuate the manual fire alarm



Emergency number 112

Get to safety

Warn persons at risk / actuate  
the fire alarm

Assist others in need of help

Close doors



Follow the destined  
emergency exits



Do not use the lift

Go to the assembly point

Follow instructions

Attempt to  
extinguish the  
fire



Use the fire extinguisher



Use the fire hose



Use means and devices for  
fire-fighting (e. g. fire blanket)
